Head Coach, Randy Dedini, began his 11-year professional career after playing two years at Sonoma State as the starting goalkeeper and graduating with a B.S. in kinesiology. In 1993, he was an All-American, and in 1992 and 1993 he received all-conference honors.

Randy's professional career included playing for the Colorado Rapids, L.A. Galaxy, Pittsburgh Riverhounds, Nashville Metros, Chico Rooks, and North Bay Breakers.

Prior to joining Sac United in 2004 Randy coached at Sonoma State, Chico State, and Duquesne Universities. He is currently the head coach for the Division I soccer program at Sacramento State where he earned the Big Sky Coach of the Year in 2007. The Hornets successful program can be attributed to Randy's aggressive offensive style and his ability to get the most out of his players.

Dedini is a Northern California native, graduating from Vacaville High School in 1988 and playing for two seasons at American River Junior College. He and his wife Katie have two daughters, Jordyn and Jaycie, and one son, Jake.

Club

Sacramento United is a non-profit membership-based club that is devoted to the development and education of soccer players and supporters of all ages. Since 1977, Sac United jerseys have been proudly worn by players striving to become better at the game they love and supported by talented, professional coaches and a well-organized parent volunteer corps.

Leadership

The coaching staff, many of whom are Sac United alumni themselves and have children of their own playing for the club, is led by Technical Director Shawn Blakeman.

Blakeman, who draws upon international and domestic professional soccer playing and coaching experience, believes in long-term individual player development over short-term winning. His motto, “one club, one love,” reflects Blakeman’s relentless efforts to bring to the Sac United community the best experiences enjoyed by members of established soccer clubs outside of the United States.

In 2009, Sac United was among a select few U.S. youth soccer clubs selected for partnership by ACF Fiorentina, the Italian professional soccer club well-known for developing players from within.

Requirements to Participate

Competitive soccer involves a commitment of time and resources by the player and player’s family. Prospective players are encouraged to join in a few training sessions. While the players see firsthand how they like it, family members can visit on the sidelines with Sac United members who will share their experiences first hand. If accepted into one of Sac United’s youth programs, the prospective player must be sponsored by an adult member, usually a parent or other family member, who will accept responsibility for the player’s financial, volunteer and good conduct obligations to the club and their team.

Membership

The annual membership fee is \$100 in return for which the member receives a member t-shirt; two tickets to the Kick-Off Social, an adults-only mixer in June; and \$50 scrip to the club’s fireworks booth in July. In a continuing effort to encourage socializing amongst club members, Sac United organizes other opt-in events such as a 5k X-Country Challenge in April and President’s Golf Challenge in June.

An additional \$100 annual volunteer fee is credited back to the member’s account after completion of fifteen hours at club events including the mixer, fireworks booth, and tournaments.

Cost

There is no cost to tryout for Sac United.

Once accepted to a team costs include:

- ⚽ Membership Fee \$100
- ⚽ Refundable Volunteer Deposit \$100
- ⚽ Club Fees \$1320
- ⚽ Team Fees \$300 (estimate)
- ⚽ Uniform \$300
- ⚽ Additional costs for individual player equipment, hotel, travel, etc ...

The season runs from April 2010 through March 2011. A ten month payment program is available for Club Fees (\$132/month April – January).

The myth that all competitive soccer teams travel every weekend across the country is simply false. The vast majority of our matches are in the Sacramento area while some are in the Bay Area. Traditionally we plan one or two tournaments in California that require overnight lodging.

eXtreme participates in a variety of team and optional individual fundraisers to help defray costs.

A scholarship program is available for those in need of financial assistance.
